# HAVNEGADEN

Havnegade has always been an important route through the city of Vejle.

When Vejle Harbour was originally inaugurated in 1827, the street was called “Havneveien.” It quickly became a desirable place to build homes, and several of the city’s wealthy residents as well as a number of public officials were among the first to settle there.

By the 1840s, the amount of building along Havnegade had increased so much that the newspaper Vejle Amts Avis warned it might threaten the street’s character as “a shady avenue leading down to the harbour.”

# HAVNEGADEN

Today, Havnegade is still an important street in Vejle, connecting the city centre with the harbour area. The surroundings have changed significantly over time and now include modern housing, businesses, and redeveloped waterfront spaces. The area has become a lively part of the city, blending historical surroundings with new urban development along the fjord.

# BOMULDS SPINDERIET

The cotton mills in Vejle played an important role in the city's industrial history.


When Vejle Cotton Mill started production in 1892, it marked the beginning of a major industrial adventure. Around the year 1900, Vejle became one of the most active industrial cities in Denmark and earned the nickname **“Denmark’s Manchester.”**

The factory at Havnegade finally closed in 2000 after 108 years of operation.

Today, the historic factory building has been transformed into student housing. The old industrial structure has been preserved, including the characteristic roof with windows that provide natural light, creating a unique living environment in the center of Vejle.





## **Open Call – Become part of Vejle Street Art 2026**

The artworks must be created as part of Vejle Street Art, which will take place between June 29 and July 5, 2026.

The Municipality of Vejle once again invites artists to participate in Vejle Street Art. This year the event will take place along Havnegade, between the train station and the harbor.

We are looking for a wide range of artistic expressions within street art — this can include everything from wall-based works, community-engaging projects, sculptures, and much more. We encourage you to let your creativity run free!

**Theme: “HOPE”**

### **Where do I apply?**

You do not necessarily need to have a fully developed artwork to apply. We are open to dialogue and early ideas, so it is sufficient to submit a portfolio or a link to examples of previous works.

### **How will my application be evaluated?**

Your application will be reviewed by a jury. The jury consists of a broad range of art professionals with insight into both the national and local art scene.

We place emphasis on artistic quality and diversity, and we value artists with different levels of experience.

### **Budget / Payment**

You must submit your own proposal for the fee for your artwork or participation.

There is no fixed fee — typically the amount has ranged between 15,000–25,000 DKK, but it can be both lower or higher depending on the project.

Artwork fee is with materials included – its up to you to define the total amount.

### **Requirements for the artworks**

The creation of the art is a central part of the experience. Therefore, the artworks must be created during the Street Art week, meaning between June 29 and July 5.
